



SNFilms Confidential Project Submission & Non-Disclosure Agreement

This Confidential Project Submission & Non-Disclosure Agreement (“Agreement”) is entered into between **Senwot Network Films, hereinafter referred to as, “SNFilms”, located at 4002 Highway 78 W, Suite 530-195, Snellville, Georgia 30039**, and the submitting client (“Client”) for the purpose of evaluating a proposed film or media project and developing the **SNFilms Production Finance Portfolio**.

This Agreement ensures that all materials submitted to SNFilms are handled with strict confidentiality and used solely for the purpose of evaluating and developing the SNFilms Production Finance Portfolio, as well as establishes the terms under which project materials may be submitted to SNFilms and the conditions under which those materials will be reviewed and handled.

1. Purpose of Submission

The Client intends to submit certain project materials to SNFilms so that SNFilms may evaluate the financial structure, production scope, and funding readiness of the project and, if engaged, develop a **Production Finance Portfolio** to support the project’s financing and production planning.

Submitted materials may include, but are not limited to:

- scripts
- treatments
- story outlines
- character biographies
- pitch decks
- production plans
- production schedules
- budget information
- financial strategies
- research materials
- development notes
- other supporting materials related to the project

These materials are collectively referred to as “**Confidential Materials.**”

2. Confidentiality Commitment

SNFilms agrees to treat all Confidential Materials submitted by the Client as confidential and will not disclose, distribute, reproduce, or exploit the submitted materials for any purpose other than:

- evaluating the project
- conducting production finance analysis
- preparing the SNFilms Production Finance Portfolio

SNFilms will take reasonable steps to ensure that submitted materials are handled in a secure and confidential manner.

3. Ownership of Intellectual Property

All intellectual property rights in the submitted project and all accompanying materials remain the sole property of the Client.

Submission of materials to SNFilms does **not transfer or assign any ownership rights** in the project or its underlying intellectual property.

4. No Production or Distribution Rights

SNFilms is engaged solely to provide **production finance diagnostic services and financial planning documentation**.

SNFilms does not acquire, claim, or request any production, development, ownership, or distribution rights in the submitted project as a result of this submission.

5. Similar Concepts and Industry Overlap

The Client acknowledges that SNFilms may review or work with other projects that contain themes, concepts, subject matter, or creative elements that are similar to the submitted project.

Submission of materials does not grant the Client exclusive rights to ideas, concepts, themes, or subject matter that may exist elsewhere in the marketplace.

6. Use of Submitted Materials

Submitted materials will be used solely for the purpose of:

- evaluating the project
- identifying financial and production risks
- developing the SNFilms Production Finance Portfolio
- supporting funding and production planning documentation

SNFilms will not independently develop, produce, distribute, or otherwise exploit the submitted project without the Client’s direct involvement and written agreement.

7. Term of Confidentiality

SNFilms agrees to maintain the confidentiality of submitted materials for a period of **five (5) years** from the date of submission, except where disclosure is required by law.

After this period, the confidentiality obligation shall expire unless otherwise agreed in writing.

8. No Obligation to Proceed

Submission of project materials does not obligate SNFilms to accept the project for services or to enter into any further business relationship.

SNFilms reserves the right to decline projects based on scope, feasibility, or production readiness.

9. Accuracy of Submitted Information

The Client represents that all submitted materials are owned by the Client or that the Client has the legal right to submit such materials for review.

The Client is responsible for the accuracy of all information provided.

10. Entire Agreement

This Agreement represents the understanding between SNFilms and the Client regarding the submission and handling of project materials.

Any modifications must be made in writing and signed by both parties.
